In response to growing concerns over air quality, we're now integrating AQ data into your Perry Weather dashboard – at no additional cost. You now have access to:

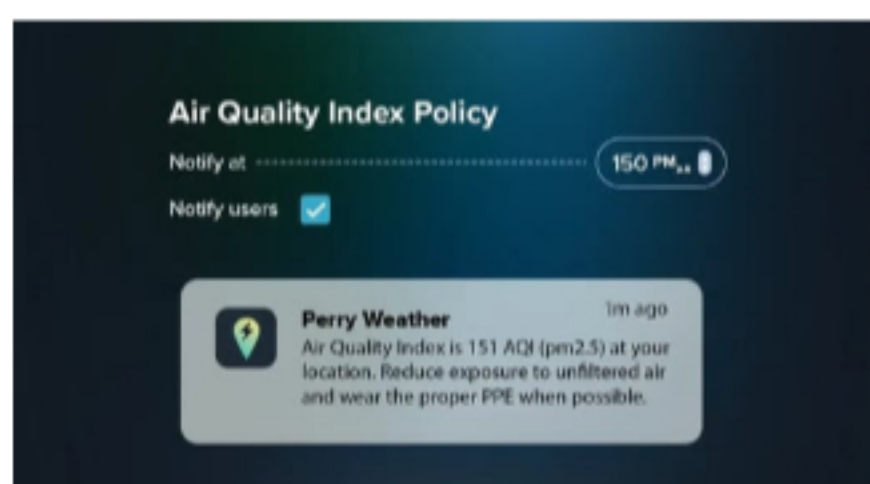
- Air quality data, including PM2.5, PM10 and Ozone pollutant tracking

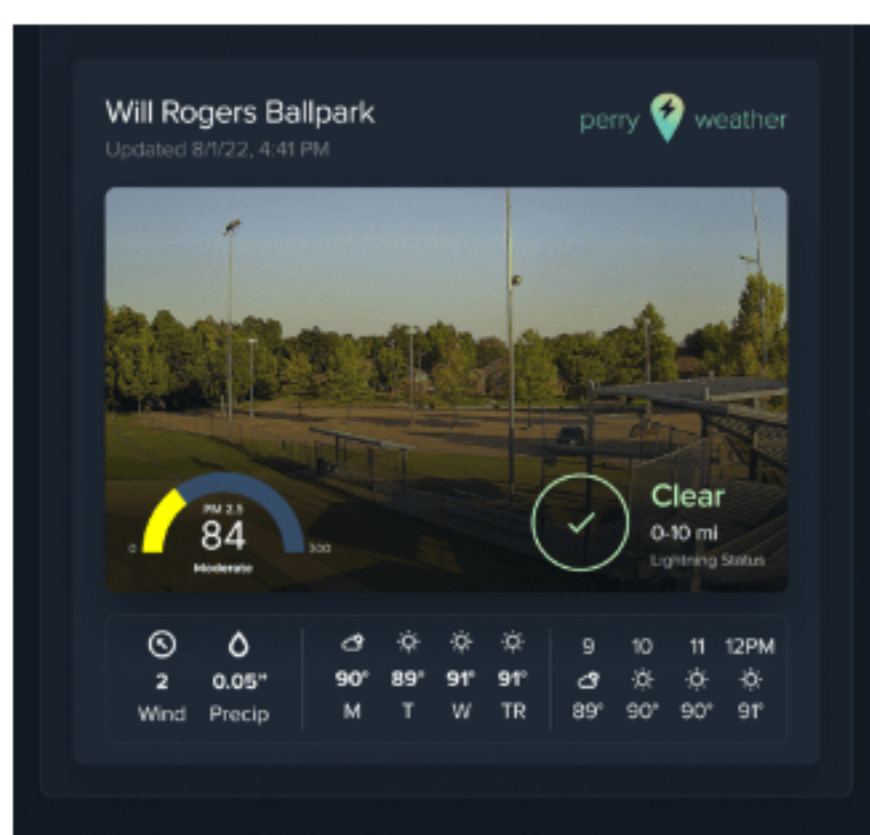

## Frequently Asked Questions

### If I don't have an air quality sensor or on-site weather station, where is this data coming from?

Your dashboard will integrate data from an AQ sensor monitored by Perry Weather or one of our partners. Customers within 10 miles of an AQ sensor (that's you!) can now access this data in their Perry Weather dashboard.

### Is this data updated in real time?

Air quality data is updated every 45 minutes. For faster and more reliable air quality alerts, we recommend you [install a Perry Weather air quality sensor](#), which will provide data every 15 minutes from your exact location.

### What pollutants are tracked in my dashboard?

Your current dashboard displays pollutants PM2.5, PM10 and Ozone to provide you with a more complete view of air quality conditions in your area.
